THERE ARE THREE SCHOLARSHIPS YOU CAN APPLY FOR THROUGH THE CDA!

Public Housing Authorities Director's Association (PHADA) – DUE JANUARY 17, 2020

In order to encourage academic excellence and community responsibility among high school students, PHADA has implemented a scholarship program for graduating seniors who are preparing to enter college. PHADA will award three scholarships to deserving youth currently residing in CDA-assisted housing:

- Steven J. Bollinger Memorial Scholarship-\$7,000
- Freedom & Civil Rights Scholarship-\$5,000
- Nan McKay Pathway to Achievement Scholarship-\$5,000

National Association of Housing & Redevelopment Officials (NAHRO) – DUE MARCH 6, 2020

You must be a resident of a CDA-assisted household and be enrolled in a post-secondary program beginning in 2020. Education programs must be accredited and may not be graduate or post graduate programs. Essay and letter of recommendation requirements vary if you are a high school senior or an adult student—see website for these and other requirements.

- NAHRO Educational Scholarship-\$1,000

Scott County CDA Educational Scholarship Program – DUE MAY 2020

The CDA will award scholarships to students living in CDA-assisted housing and enrolled in a post secondary education program beginning in 2020. Vocational/technical or two-year college programs are eligible and must be accredited. Essay and letter of recommendation requirements vary if you are a high school senior or an adult student—see website for these and other requirements.

- CDA Educational Scholarship-\$2,000*

*up to but not exceeding actual school program cost
