

2021 SCOTT COUNTY CDA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Scott County CDA will award scholarships to students living in CDA-assisted housing and enrolled in post-secondary educational programs for the spring of 2021. Vocational/technical or two-year college programs are eligible and must be accredited. Scholarships must be used for any accredited post-secondary education programs, except for graduate or post-graduate programs.

To be eligible to apply for the Scott County CDA scholarship program, the applicant must:

Be a resident of a publicly-owned housing unit or a participant in a rent assistance program.

Be enrolled in a post-secondary program or be accepted into a post-secondary program beginning winter/spring 2021.

Education programs must be accredited and may not be graduate or post-graduate programs.

Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or better on a scale of 4.0. (Applies to current students only).

HOW TO APPLY:

Return the completed application to our agency by December 1st by 4:00 p.m.

Applications can be downloaded from our website, www.scottcda.org, or can be mailed to you upon request.

Applications from high school seniors and adult students must include the following:

An essay (no more than 2 typed pages) detailing the applicant's goals, commitment to post-secondary education, and outline of the applicant's career plan.

The applicant's high school or post-secondary transcript mailed **directly from the school to our agency.**

One letter of recommendation from a teacher or school official who is familiar with the applicant's academic performance or a letter of character reference from an employer or community/volunteer organization.

Information on education institutions that have accepted the applicant, or where the application for enrollment has been made (see back page).

AWARD DISTRIBUTION INFORMATION:

Applications will be reviewed by the CDA scholarship committee. Recipients will be notified by mail. Award letter/s will be mailed the week of December 15th.
