



2021 SCOTT COUNTY CDA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Scott County CDA will award (4) types of scholarships in 2021. **Eligibility requirements are:**

- Applicants must be a resident of a housing unit owned by Scott County CDA or a current participant in a rent assistance program administered by Scott County CDA.
- Applicants must be planning to or are in the process of working toward a certificate, Associate's degree, or Bachelor's degree. Scholarships are not eligible for Master's or Post-Graduate degrees.
- Applicants who are currently High School Seniors must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale.
- The university, college, or vocational program applicants are enrolled or plan to be enrolled in must be an accredited educational program.
- If applying for the CDA 4 Year College & University Educational Scholarship, the applicant must be enrolled in a 4 year post-secondary program beginning Fall 2021.
- If applying for the CDA 2 Year Vocational & Technical College Educational Scholarship, the applicant must be enrolled in a 2 year Vocational & Technical College beginning Fall 2021.
- If applying for the Ken Dahl Memorial Vocational Scholarship, the applicant must be enrolled in a 2 year Vocational & Technical College and majoring in construction or related housing fields beginning the Fall 2021.
- If applying for the Front-line Futures Certificate Program, the applicant must be a front line worker and enrolled in a Certificate program course beginning Fall 2021.

How to apply:

Return the completed application to our agency by May 10th, 2021 by 4:00 p.m. Applications can be downloaded from our website, www.scottcda.org, or can be mailed to you upon request.

All applicants are required to include:

- An essay (no more than 2 single-spaced typed pages) detailing the applicant's goals, commitment to post-secondary education, and outline of the applicant's career plan.
- Two letters of recommendation from teachers, school officials, or supervisors familiar with the applicant's academic performance and/or work performance.
- Information on education institutions that have accepted the applicant, or where the applicant has applied to study (please list on back page).

In addition, applications from High School Seniors must include the following:

- The applicant's high school transcript mailed **directly from the high school to our agency**.

Award distribution information:

Applications will be reviewed by the CDA Scholarship Committee. Recipients will be notified by mail. Award letters will be mailed the week of May 17th, 2021. Amounts awarded may vary and will not exceed actual program costs.
