



## Bring It Home Program Housing Wait-List Opening *Lease-in-Place Opportunity!*

### **What is the Bring it Home Voucher Program?**

Bring it Home is a State-funded rent assistance program that helps people pay rent each month for privately owned rental housing. No different than our other voucher programs, participants will typically pay 30% of their income on rent with the Bring it Home voucher covering the difference.

**To be eligible to apply**, you must be an applicant on our HCV, PBV, or Rural Development waiting lists as of 4/12/26, currently living in Scott County, and meet income and other eligibility criteria listed in this flyer.

### **Lease-in-Place Opportunity:**

Households may remain in their current housing while receiving Bring it Home rental assistance. We will screen all eligible applicants for Lease-in-Place eligibility. If a household is unable to stay where they live, they will be given the option to move within Scott County with the voucher.

### **When is the waiting list open?**

Scott County CDA will accept online applications from: **Monday, April 13, 2026 8:00am to Thursday, April 16, 2026 4:00pm**

### **How do I apply?**

- Applications will be accepted online only at: <https://portal.scottcda.org/> (click on "Applicant login" on the top right)
- Applicants may use any computer, tablet, or smartphone with internet access to apply, including free computers at public libraries.
- Applications will not be available at the Scott County CDA offices
- Fax or e-mail requests will not be accepted.

### **Can I edit my application after I submit it?**

- Yes, you can edit your application by logging into your online portal at <https://portal.scottcda.org/> (click on "Applicant login")



**What information do I need to apply?**

- A valid email address
- Names and birth dates for all household members
- The household’s gross annual income

**What are the eligibility requirements for applying?**

- You must be a Scott County resident at time of this application
- You must have an active, eligible application as of 4/12/26 on one of the following Scott County CDA waiting lists: HCV Waiting List, PBV Waiting List, or Rural Development Waiting List. *\*Prairie Pointe, Prior Manor, and Mainstream do not qualify under this preference.*
- You cannot receive any other housing subsidy
- You cannot port the voucher to a different County or State
- Your household must be considered cost burdened (paying more than 30% of income on rent) and cannot make more money than the 50% AMI income limits (see chart)

**How will households be placed on the waiting list?**

- Eligible households will be placed on the waiting list by date and time with additional preference points given to households with children age 18 and under and households making 30% of the AMI or below.

**How will we determine the voucher size?**

- Your household size must qualify for the appropriate unit size. We assign the first bedroom to the head of household and a spouse/partner, if applicable, and then each additional bedroom – to the next two persons regardless of sex, age, or relationship.
- The following circumstances are exceptions: Live-in aides will be allocated a separate bedroom and foster adults and foster children will be allocated separate bedrooms.
